

The meeting of the Academic Council for 2018-19 was held on 12/06/2018 at 02 PM in the Staff Common Room under the Chairmanship of Dr. Debendranath Behera, Principal Government Autonomous College, Rourkela.

2. Business Transacted :

- i. At the outset, the Principal, Dr. Debendranath Behera, extended a warm welcome to all the members of the academic council for making it convenient to attend the meeting.
- ii. Dr. Debendranath Behera, Principal, Government Autonomous College, Rourkela was felicitated by Dr. Pravat Kumar Mallick, Member, Academic Council, for being awarded the Best Educationalist Award by International Institute of Education and Management, at New Delhi on 24th May 2018.
- iii. Prof. Kichak Chandra Jena, Academic Bursar read out the proceeding of the last Academic Council meeting held on 03/11/2017 which was approved by the august body.
- iv. The Principal, Dr. Debendranath Behera initiated the discussion & presented the detail account of various developmental activities undertaken and completed during the year.
- v. Syllabi recommended by various Board of Studies (UG & PG) under CBCS System were placed before the council for discussion and were approved.

3. Difficulties pointed out by the Members :

- i. Dr. (Mrs) Sasmita Samal, HOD Chemistry and Dr. Biswanath Parija, Asst. Professor, Physics narrated the difficulties in managing the department without non-teaching staff.
- ii. Dr. (Mrs) Basanti Kujur, Deputy Controller of Examinations, narrated the problems related to Examination Database Management without a System Analyst/System Administrator as the number of students has increased which leads to late result declaration also.
- iii. Proposal given by Coordinator, Self-Financing regarding PPP mode of operation for Self-financing courses was discussed.
- iv. Prof. Kichak Chandra Jena, Academic Bursar, pointed out the problems related to old students those are taking admission in PG Courses as they are more involved in other non academic works rather than academics and creating problems in college.

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
4. Suggestions made by the members.

- i. Regarding the difficulties in managing the departments without non-teaching staff, Dr. Iswar Prasad Mohanty, Administrative Bursar, suggested to write letters to appropriate authority in Higher Education Department of Odisha for posting adequate staff from the current session in order to maintain Common Minimum Standard and to impart quality education to the students. This suggestion was accepted unanimously.
- ii. Regarding the Examination Database Management of the students, Dr. Pravat Kumar Mallick Member, Academic Council, suggested to build a central database of the students for the smooth running of the Academics, Examination and other co-curricular activities of the college. He also suggested appointing a System Analyst/System Administrator having minimum MCA degree with minimum 10 years experience in teaching and software development. The system Analyst/System Administrator should also be responsible for the college website development, management and uploading of related information.
- iii. Proposal given by Coordinator, Self Financing regarding PPP mode of operation for Self-financing courses was not approved unanimously due to non availability of rooms and this will also lead to poor academic result.
- iv. Prof. Sanjat Kumar Sahoo suggested for publishing activity calendar for each year from the beginning of the academic session.
- v. Prof. A.K.Dasmohapatra suggested for publishing the paper discussed in the seminar conducted by the departments and as well in the consortia of journals approved by UGC.
- vi. Prof. A.K. Dasmohapatra and Prof. S. Dash proposed to make syllabus of Arts, Science & Commerce skill oriented to make the students professionally skilled so that the students can face challenges of globalization. In this context they also suggested to tie up with Odisha State Open University, (OSOU) Sambalpur for the benefit of students.
- vii. Prof. S.K. Sahoo insisted to make NAAC reaccreditation as early as possible to get funds from UGC. He also narrated the new and revised guidelines laid by UGC for NAAC reaccreditation.
- viii. Advocate Sadananda Sahoo suggested holding meetings/ seminar/ workshops/ conference for awareness regarding the legal matters in the college.
- ix. All members suggested to conduct Workshops/ National & State Level Seminars in the college for the betterment of the stake holders. They also discussed about the feedback information from the stake holders.
- x. Academic Bursar suggested for forming of Students' Council instead of Students' Union and placed the resolution of Staff Council Meeting dated 21.01.2018 for approval.

5. Resolutions made :


It was unanimously decided to :

2. **BUSINESS TRANSACTED :**

- a) At the outset, the Principal, Dr.(Mrs.) Prativa Sahoo extended a warm welcome to all the members of the Academic Council for making it convenient to attend the meeting.
- b) Sri K.C. Jena, Academic Bursar read out the Proceedings of the last Academic Council meeting held on 24.08.2013 which was approved by the august body.
- c) The Principal, Dr. (Mrs.) Prativa Sahoo initiated discussions. She presented the detail account of various developmental activities undertaken and completed during the year.
- d) Syllabi recommended by the Board of Studies held on 05.05.2014 and 24.09.2014 were placed before the Council for discussion and was approved.
- e) Syllabus for newly opened course, Diploma in Retail Management of Community College established in Government Autonomous College, Rourkela was placed before the Council by Dr. N. Patel, Nodal Officer for discussion and the same was approved.
- f) The Syllabus of Philosophy, Sociology and Psychology for 2012-15 were allowed to continue for the session 2014-17.

3. **DIFFICULTIES POINTED OUT BY THE MEMBERS :**

- a) Smt. M. Patra, Reader in Physics pointed out the problems for conducting the Electronics Practical classes in the existing room.
- b) Dr.(Mrs.) J. Jena, Reader in Odia and Dr. (Mrs.) K.P. Kapani, Reader in Hindi drew the attention of the members to provide a separate room for conducting Seminars.
- c) Dr.(Mrs.) K.P. Kapani requested the Principal to provide more funds for extramural lectures.

9. Difficulties pointed out by the members :-

- i) Smt.M.Patra pointed out the problem of no staff in Department of Physics at Junior college level.
- ii) Sri G.R.Mohanty draw the attention to the fact of no P.E. in Athletic Society of the college. Being the students of this college are Sports/Games lovers, it must be taken up on priority basis, Sri Mohanty observed.

- III) Sri L.N.Dejury and Smt.S.Sutar narrated the difficulty in managing the Department without non-teaching staff.
- IV) The hardship of the students is discussed by Smt.K.Mishra as there is no internal valuation in the Semester-end Examination. She advocated for 50% assessment by the college staff members in order to make the valuation work qualitative.

10. Suggestions made by the members :-
